## OUR STORY

In 2016, Michael Simati started his non-profit in Bungoma, Kenya to serve widows and orphans. He never imagined that one day he might have an opportunity to build a facility to facilitate his vision of caring for widows and orphans. When a neighbor agreed to sell some land, Michael began dreaming of a multi-purpose structure place that would house a room where widows could learn to sew, a lab for teaching computer skills and a medical clinic. This new facility could become "home" for Wiphan Kenya, and its identity in the community.

The Sewing Skills Training program for widows began in 2018. At the time, no one knew how to sew, but now ladies are supporting themselves by creating fabric items which are sold in Kenya and the US. The biggest challenge is the ladies have no permanent place to set up their machines. YOU can help them to improve their sewing skills and increase production by building a training classroom!

Another one of Wiphan Kenya's goals is to start a Computer Skills Training Program. Employees with computer skills are in high demand insuring students a job at the end of their training. A computer skills training program requires space for a fully equipped computer lab. YOUR investment will provide a place for this innovative Computer Skills Training program, ultimately providing jobs for widows and older orphans!

Finally, the third room will be used as a dormitory for widows and orphans traveling to Bungoma for training and as a community health clinic. YOU can provide skills training students with lodging and the community with a much-needed medical clinic.



## TIMELINE

- October 2019 begin fundraising
- February 2020 begin construction
- July 2020 first classroom completed
- September 2020 second classroom completed
- October 2020 Medical clinic completed
- November 2020 Ministry begins in the new building

## INVESTMENT

- \$13,000 for the land which includes access to electricity and public water
- \$12,000 per each 10 x 20 room retrofitted with electricity and WIFI
- \$3,000 indoor restrooms

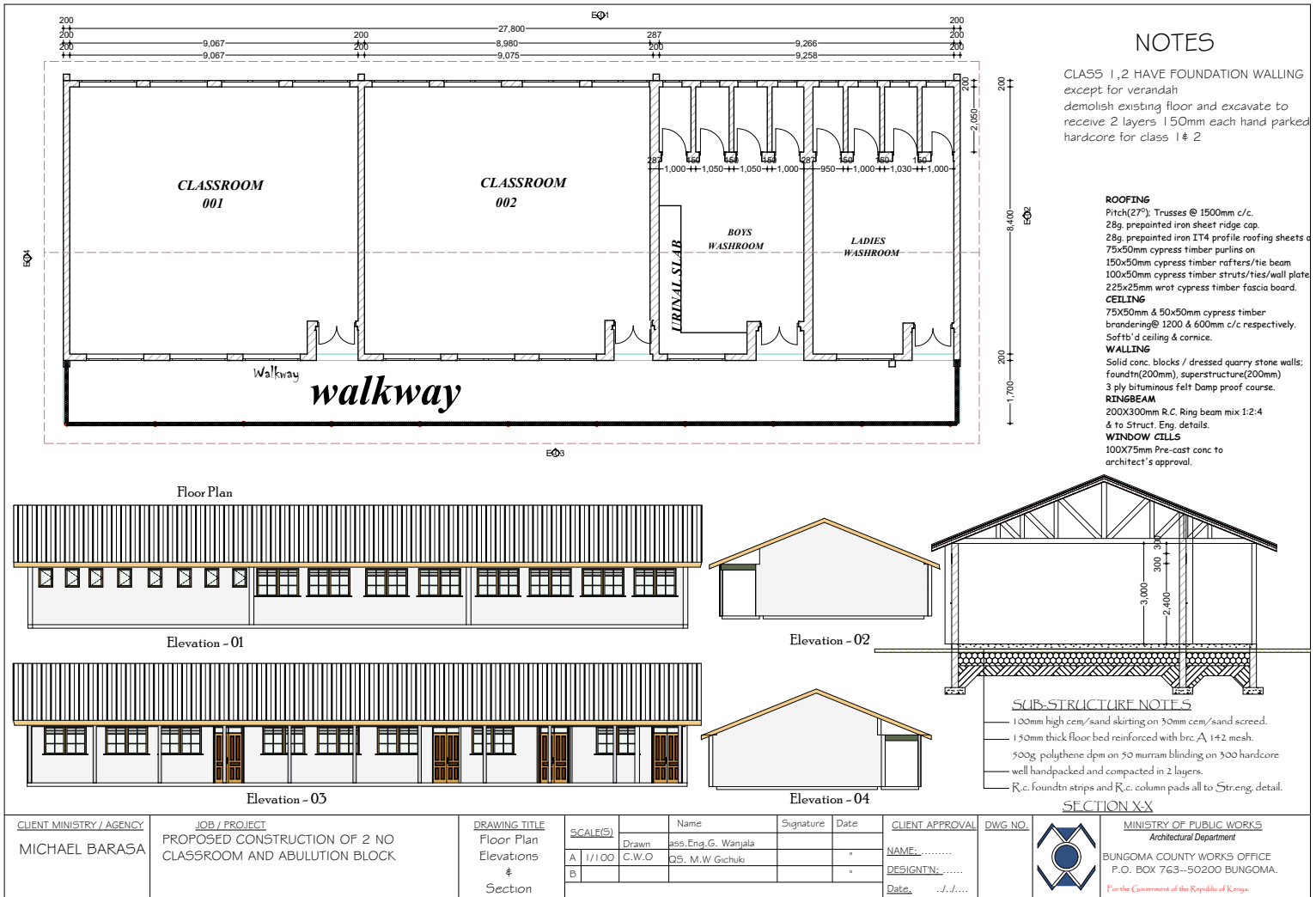
